

## **LUZIFERLAMPS WINS THE SPANISH NATIONAL CRAFTS AWARD 2011**

*Promoted by the Spanish Ministry for Industry, Tourism and Trade and organised by the **Fundación Española para la Innovación de la Artesanía** (Spanish Foundation for Innovation in Crafts), the VI National Craft Awards have been released on the 2<sup>nd</sup> November in Madrid. Luziferlamps has been awarded with the main prize due to its careful handmade production process together with its commitment to design.*

Madrid, 2<sup>nd</sup> November 2011. -The Spanish National Crafts Awards reward excellent and exemplary actions of Spanish contemporary crafts. Its main goal is to promote the development and competitiveness of Spanish crafts SME's by encouraging innovation, design and the ability to adapt to the current market situation.

These awards include five categories:

- The **National Crafts Prize** (priced with 14.000€), rewards a consolidated career in the crafts sector. It has been awarded to the mentioned [Luziferlamps, S.L.](#)
- The **Product Prize** (priced with 7.000€) for the best product or collection of the last 2 years, has been awarded to [Luesma Vega](#).
- The **Innovation Prize** (priced with 7.000€), for innovative products and actions related to crafts in the field of technology, materials, design or commercialization, has been declared void.
- The **Promotion Prize for private entities** (priced with 7.000€) rewards private entities that have contributed in a significant way to the promotion of crafts. It has been awarded to [Regalcerámica](#).
- The **Promotion Prize for public entities** rewards public institutions that have contributed in a significant way to the promotion of crafts. The winner of this edition has been the [Centro de Artesanía de la Comunidad Valenciana](#).

A selection of the pieces from the winners and shortlists of the VI Spanish National Crafts Awards will be on show till the 29<sup>th</sup> November from 9.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. in the seat of the Spanish Ministry for Industry, Tourism and Trade in Madrid (Paseo de la Castellana 162). The exhibition will itinerate afterwards to other Spanish cities.
